Annual Club Meeting

A vote was taken and the motion passed.

Anthony discussed the fact that the power bills continue to increase and that the club wants to lime all greenfields. To cover these expenses the club needs to raise more revenue and the only way this can happen is by increasing the annual club dues. It was decided that the dues would increase by \$100.00 per year. \$50.00 to be marked for the added electrical cost and the other \$50.00 for funding the liming of the fields. A motion was made to raise the annual club dues and the vote was taken and passed.

Seth brought up that fact the rules committee needed to refresh themselves on the measuring of the bucks antlers and doe body weight along with the other requirements on who and how deer are measured.

Motion was made to adjourn the meeting, this was seconded and vote was made.
